### **Introduction**

Placing the study in the context of current knowledge and prior theoretical and empirical work on the topic the author should provide a clear rationale for why the problem deserves other researcher's attention. The introduction should provide the specific problems addressed and the main goal(s) of the study.

### **Method**

In this section, the author should present a description of the research procedure (what, how and when it has been done and how the data were analyzed and presented). The statistical procedures used to analyze and summarize the data should also be taken into account.

### **Results**

The Results section should describe the most important findings of the study, analysis, or experiment. Results should be clear and concise. It is important to highlight the most important findings and describe the relevant trends and patterns.

### **Discussion/Conclusion**

The Discussion/Conclusion should provide an evaluation of the results. There should be a clear discussion of the implications, significance, and novelty of the results presented and whether the data support or contradict previous studies. Finally, the main conclusions of the research can be presented.
